

CONTINUING PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT 2008-2009

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

The Institution of Surveyors NSW Inc.

A total of 15 points for renewal of membership. This total must include 3 “Cadastral” and/or “Speciality” points, and the remainder as “Survey Practice” points.

Events cannot be rolled over from one year to another.

Excess “Cadastral/Speciality” may be classified as “Survey Practice” points.

Survey practice may include matters relating to:

- Technology Use related to Surveying
- Infrastructure and Engineering
- Environment and Planning
- Building Development
- Subdivision Development
- Project Management
- Professional Practice Management
- Mine planning and Development
- Risk Management

Members will be required to complete a declaration that they have met the Institution’s CPD policy requirements at the time of renewing their Membership.

The CPD Sub-committee will conduct an audit of 5% of all claims

Institution Members who have completed their CPD returns, only need forward their Record Sheet to the ISNSW office for assessment, **IF** they require issue of the Institution’s CPD Certificate.

Issue of a CPD Certificate indicates compliance with BoSSI CPD Determination.

Non Institution Members could also request issue of the Institution’s CPD Certificate – Institution fees for processing and issue of such a Certificate is payable (Currently fixed at \$250.00 incl. GST)
